Ashes will be distributed at each of these masses. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. For Catholics, fasting is the reduction of one's intake of food, while abstinence refers to refraining from meat [or another type of food] the Catholic Church teaches us that all people are obliged by God to perform some penance for their sins, and that these acts of penance are both personal and corporeal. The purpose of fasting is spiritual focus, self discipline, imitation of Christ, and performing penance. Bodily fasting is meaningless unless it is joined with a spiritual fast from sin.
