THE RITE OF BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN IN THE PARISH OF MOONCOIN

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated in our parish at 4pm on the following days:

Carrigeen 1st Saturday of every month Mooncoin 2nd Saturday of every month Kilnaspic 3rd Saturday of every month

To arrange a baptism please contact the Parish Office on 051 895123

We ask parents to give 3-4 weeks notice. Two members of the preparation team will contact and visit each family before the Baptism with the 'Pack For Parents' which consists of a book 'Lets Celebrate Baptism', an information sheet to explain the journey of Baptism (this journey will begin at the door of the church), they will also have the prayers and readings for the celebration and a house blessing. The priest will visit each family after the Baptism. As Baptism is a community celebration all children baptised during the year will be presented to the faith community on a designated day each year.
