Power in Weakness

While the world rarely celebrates vulnerability, Jesus applauds our transparency. Authentic love helps to sustain us all during seasons of frailty. Some days we need help navigating stormy seas with waves that threaten to take us under. On other days we are aboard the ship, tossing out a life ring to others. In either case, a silver lining of blessing pushes through adversity's cloud.

Our Saviour modelled strength in weakness. He proved spiritual strength triumphs over physical, emotional, or mental weakness. He showed compassion and caring to friends and enemies alike, and taught us to rely upon one another. Jesus didn't keep a "stiff upper lip" – he wept, and sees our tears now. In our weakness and desperation, we allow him closer.

Helping others experiencing weakness extends Jesus' earthly ministry. Be available. Rely on God's strength; seek his blessing. Respond with faith, not criticism. Show compassion, aiding everyone you meet with tender, humble, loving care. Just as Jesus loves us.
