We ask parents to give 3-4 weeks notice. Two members of the preparation team will contact and visit each family before the Baptism with the 'Pack For Parents' which consists of a book 'Lets Celebrate Baptism', an information sheet to explain the journey of Baptism (this journey will begin at the door of the church), they will also have the prayers and readings for the celebration and a house blessing. The priest will visit each family

after the Baptism. As Baptism is a community celebration all children baptised during the year will be presented to the faith community on a designated day each year.
