The Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government have put in place a commission to review the Waterford / Kilkenny county boundary. This has not been initiated by our neighbours and friends in Waterford or by Waterford City and County Council. The Dept. has put this in place. However no reasonable person in any county would accept a change to their county boundary in order to create efficiencies or whatever other reasons are at the back of this. This can be done by ongoing co-operation among the Local Authorities and Municipal Areas working and pulling together. Your presence and views are needed. Don't leave this to others.
